## A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to ensure that the National Driver Registry includes certain information.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. NATIONAL DRIVER REGISTRY ENHANCEMENT.**

4       (a) INFORMATION REGARDING CERTAIN DRIVERS.—

5       Section 30304(b)(1) of title 49, United States Code, is  
6       amended—

7               (1) by redesignating subparagraphs (B) and  
8               (C) as subparagraphs (C) and (D), respectively; and

9               (2) by inserting after subparagraph (A) the fol-  
10       lowing:

1 “(B) information that specifies if an indi-  
2 vidual has been convicted in the previous 10  
3 years under the laws of the State of operating  
4 a motor vehicle under the influence of, or im-  
5 paired by, alcohol or a controlled substance;”.

6 (b) APPLICATION.—The amendments made by sub-  
7 section (a) shall apply to a conviction described in section  
8 30304(b)(1)(B) of title 49, United States Code, that oc-  
9 curs on or after the date of enactment of this Act.

10 **SEC. 2. ACCESS TO REGISTER INFORMATION.**

11 Section 30305(b) of title 49, United States Code, is  
12 amended by adding at the end the following:

13 “(12) A State or local prosecutor and district  
14 attorney may request the chief driver licensing offi-  
15 cial of a State to obtain information under sub-  
16 section (a) about an individual who is under inves-  
17 tigation for a traffic related offense. A prosecutor  
18 and a district attorney may receive the informa-  
19 tion.”.
