A BILL

To authorize the use of Strategic Petroleum Reserve capacity above 700,000,000 barrels to address sustained petroleum product price increases.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS.
- 4 Section 161 of the Energy Policy and Conservation
- 5 Act (42 U.S.C. 6241) is amended by adding at the end
- 6 the following new subsection:
- 7 "(k) Sustained Price Increases.—Notwith-
- 8 standing subsections (d) and (h) (except for paragraph
- 9 (2)(A) and (B) of subsection (h)), the Secretary may draw
- 10 down and sell petroleum products from the Strategic Pe-

- 1 troleum Reserve to address sustained petroleum product
- 2 price increases in the United States that could have an
- 3 adverse impact on the Nation's economy, whether there
- 4 has been a supply interruption or shortage or not. The
- 5 Secretary may not reduce the capacity of the Strategic Pe-
- 6 troleum Reserve under this subsection to less than
- 7 700,000,000 barrels of petroleum product.".

8 SEC. 2. SAVINGS PROVISION.

- 9 Nothing in the amendment made by section 1 shall
- 10 be construed to limit or alter the authority of the Sec-
- 11 retary to draw down petroleum products under section
- 12 161(a) through (j) of the Energy Policy and Conservation
- 13 Act.

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
