For the relief of the Big Spring Independent School District.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY FOR GRANTS UNDER RURAL AND
- 4 LOW-INCOME SCHOOL PROGRAM.
- 5 The Big Spring Independent School District in the
- 6 State of Texas shall be eligible to receive a grant under
- 7 subpart 2 of part B of title VI of the Elementary and
- 8 Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7351 et seq.;
- 9 commonly referred to as the "Rural and Low-Income
- 10 School Program") for any fiscal year in which the Big
- 11 Spring Independent School District—

(1) meets the eligibility criterion of section 1 2 of U.S.C. 6221(b)(1)(A)such Act (20 3 7351(b)(1)(A); and 4 (2) would meet the eligibility criterion of section of U.S.C. 5 6221(b)(1)(B)such Act (20)7351(b)(1)(A)), but for the inclusion of the Federal 6 prison population in the calculation of the school lo-7 8 cale codes described in that section.
