A BILL

To revise the boundaries of the Golden Gate National Recreation Area in the State of California, to restore and extend the term of the advisory commission for the recreation area, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Rancho Corral de Tier-
5 ra Golden Gate National Recreation Area Boundary Ad-
6 justment Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. GOLDEN GATE NATIONAL RECREATION AREA, CALI-**
2 **FORNIA.**

3 (a) BOUNDARY ADJUSTMENT.—Section 2(a) of Pub-
4 lic Law 92–589 (16 U.S.C. 460bb–1(a)) is amended—

5 (1) by striking “The recreation area shall com-
6 prise” and inserting the following:

7 “(1) INITIAL LANDS.—The recreation area shall
8 comprise”; and

9 (2) by striking “The following additional lands
10 are also” and all that follows through the period at
11 the end of the subsection and inserting the following
12 new paragraphs:

13 “(2) ADDITIONAL LANDS.—In addition to the
14 lands described in paragraph (1), the recreation area
15 shall include the following:

16 “(A) The parcels numbered by the Asses-
17 sor of Marin County, California, 119–040–04,
18 119–040–05, 119–040–18, 166–202–03, 166–
19 010–06, 166–010–07, 166–010–24, 166–010–
20 25, 119–240–19, 166–010–10, 166–010–22,
21 119–240–03, 119–240–51, 119–240–52, 119–
22 240–54, 166–010–12, 166–010–13, and 119–
23 235–10.

24 “(B) Lands and waters in San Mateo
25 County generally depicted on the map entitled
26 ‘Sweeney Ridge Addition, Golden Gate National

1 Recreation Area’, numbered NRA GG–80,000–
2 A, and dated May 1980.

3 “(C) Lands acquired under the Golden
4 Gate National Recreation Area Addition Act of
5 1992 (16 U.S.C. 460bb–1 note; Public Law
6 102–299).

7 “(D) Lands generally depicted on the map
8 entitled ‘Additions to Golden Gate National
9 Recreation Area’, numbered NPS–80–076, and
10 dated July 2000/PWR–PLRPC.

11 “(E) Lands generally depicted on the map
12 entitled ‘Rancho Corral de Tierra Additions to
13 the Golden Gate National Recreation Area’,
14 numbered NPS–80,079C and dated January
15 2003, except that lands and interests in lands
16 constituting the Devil’s Slide Tunnel alternative
17 are not included in the recreation area. The
18 Secretary shall modify the boundary map re-
19 ferred to in this subparagraph to reflect the ex-
20 clusion of such lands and interests in lands.

21 “(3) ACQUISITION LIMITATION.—The Secretary
22 may acquire land described in paragraph (2)(E) only
23 from a willing seller.”.

24 (b) EXTENSION OF TERM OF ADVISORY COMMIS-
25 SION.—Effective as of October 26, 2002, section 5(g) of

1 Public Law 92–589 (16 U.S.C. 460bb–4(g)) is amended
2 by striking “cease to exist thirty years after the enactment
3 of this Act” and inserting “terminate at the end of the
4 10-year period beginning on the date of the enactment of
5 the Rancho Corral de Tierra Golden Gate National Recre-
6 ation Area Boundary Adjustment Act”.

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
