A BILL

To replace a Coastal Barrier Resources System map relating to Coastal Barrier Resources System Grayton Beach Unit FL-95P in Walton County, Florida.

3 **SECTION 1. REPLACEMENT OF COASTAL BARRIER RE-**
4 **SOURCES SYSTEM MAP RELATING TO**
5 **GRAYTON BEACH UNIT FL-95P IN WALTON**
6 **COUNTY, FLORIDA.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The map described in subsection
8 (b) relating to the Coastal Barrier Resources System unit
9 Grayton Beach Unit FL-95P, located in Walton County,

1 Florida, as included in the set of maps entitled “Coastal
2 Barrier Resources System” referred to in section 4(a) of
3 the Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C. 3503(a)),
4 is hereby replaced by another map relating to that unit
5 entitled “_____” and dated “_____”.

6 (b) REPLACED MAP DESCRIBED.—The map replaced
7 under subsection (a) is subtitled “COASTAL BARRIER
8 RESOURCES SYSTEM GRAYTON BEACH UNIT
9 FL-95P DRAPER LAKE UNIT FL-96” and dated Oc-
10 tober 24, 1990.

11 (c) AVAILABILITY.—The Secretary of the Interior
12 shall keep the maps referred to in subsections (a) on file
13 and available for inspection in accordance with the provi-
14 sions of section 4(b) of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act
15 (16 U.S.C. 3503(b)).
