#### **3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Save Our Waters From

5 Sewage Act of 2004".

## 6 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON SEWAGE DUMPING.

7 In administering the National Pollutant Discharge8 Elimination System permit program under the Federal

Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1251 et seq.), the
Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency
shall not promulgate any regulations or issue any guidance
documents that would authorize a publicly-owned treat ment works to divert flows to bypass a portion of its treat ment facility unless the bypass is unavoidable to prevent
loss of life, personal injury, or severe property damage.
