- 4 Treasury, Independent Agencies, and General Government
- 5 Appropriations Act, 2005 (division H of the Consolidated
- 6 Appropriations Act, 2005), is amended to read as follows:
- 7 "Sec. 522. Each agency shall have a Chief Privacy
- 8 Officer, who shall assist the agency Chief Information Of-
- 9 ficer (designated under section 3506 of title 44, United

- 1 States Code) in matters relating to the use, collection, and
- 2 disclosure of personally identifiable information.".
