5 SECTION I. CERTAIN SIGHTSEEING FLIGHTS EXEMPT

4 FROM TAXES ON AIR TRANSPORTATION.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 4281 of the Internal Rev-

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
4 this section shall apply with respect to transportation be-
5 ginning on or after the date of the enactment of this Act,
6 but shall not apply to any amount paid before such date.
