A BILL

To provide Medicare beneficiaries with access to prescription drugs at Federal Supply Schedule prices.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. ACCESS OF MEDICARE BENEFICIARIES TO PRE-4 SCRIPTION DRUGS AT FEDERAL SUPPLY 5 SCHEDULE PRICES. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any 6 7 individual who is entitled to benefits under part A, 8 or enrolled under part B, of title XVIII of the Social 9 Security Act shall be eligible to obtain prescription

- drugs at the prices specified in the Federal Supply
- 2 Schedule.
