Mr. MATSUI (for himself, Mrs. TAUSCHER, Mr. GEORGE MILLER of California, and Mr. THOMPSON of California) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

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## A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Army to carry out a project for flood damage reduction and ecosystem restoration for the American River, Sacramento, California, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Sacramento Public  
5       Safety Act of 2003”.

1 **SEC. 2. FLOOD DAMAGE REDUCTION AND ECOSYSTEM RES-**  
2 **TORATION, AMERICAN RIVER, CALIFORNIA.**

3 The Secretary of the Army is authorized to carry out  
4 the project for flood damage reduction and ecosystem res-  
5 toration, American River, Sacramento, California, sub-  
6 stantially in accordance with the plans, and subject to the  
7 conditions, described in the Report of the Chief of Engi-  
8 neers for the project dated November 5, 2002.

9 **SEC. 3. CONSTRUCTION OF PERMANENT BRIDGE ADJA-**  
10 **CENT TO FOLSOM DAM.**

11 (a) IN GENERAL.—As part of the project authorized  
12 by section 2, the Secretary of Transportation shall carry  
13 out a project to design and construct a bridge west of and  
14 adjacent to Folsom Dam, California. In carrying out the  
15 project, the Secretary shall also construct necessary link-  
16 ages from the bridge to existing roadways.

17 (b) DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION.—In designing and  
18 constructing the bridge, the Secretary shall—

19 (1) coordinate with the Secretary of the Army  
20 regarding the project authorized by section 2; and

21 (2) provide appropriate sizing and linkages to  
22 support present and future traffic flow requirements  
23 for the city of Folsom, California.

24 (c) GRANT ASSISTANCE.—The Secretary of Trans-  
25 portation shall make a grant to the State of California

- 1 in an amount sufficient to pay not less than 80 percent
- 2 of the cost of the project authorized by this section.
