A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to construct a bridge on Federal land west of and adjacent to Folsom Dam in California, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. CONSTRUCTION OF BRIDGE ADJACENT TO FOL-**
2 **SOM DAM, CALIFORNIA.**

3 (a) *IN GENERAL.*—*The Secretary of the Interior, in*
4 *coordination with the Secretaries of Transportation and*
5 *Homeland Security, may carry out a project to design and*
6 *construct a bridge on Federal land west of and adjacent*
7 *to Folsom Dam in California. In carrying out the project,*
8 *the Secretary of the Interior may also construct necessary*
9 *linkages from the bridge to existing roadways and provide*
10 *for reestablishment of administrative facilities located at the*
11 *Dam that will be affected by construction of the bridge.*

12 (b) *DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION.*—*In designing and*
13 *constructing the bridge, the Secretary of the Interior shall*
14 *maximize the economy, safety, and security of Folsom*
15 *Dam’s future operation, maintenance, and construction ac-*
16 *tivities.*

17 (c) *SIZE OF BRIDGE.*—*The Secretary of the Interior*
18 *shall construct the bridge as a 2-lane bridge unless the city*
19 *of Folsom requests, at such time as the Secretary may re-*
20 *quire, that the bridge be constructed as a 4-lane bridge. If*
21 *the city of Folsom submits such a request, the city shall*
22 *enter into an appropriate cost-sharing agreement with the*
23 *Secretary.*

24 (d) *TRANSFER TO CITY OF FOLSOM.*—*Before initiation*
25 *of construction of the bridge, the Secretary of the Interior*
26 *shall enter into an agreement with the city of Folsom to*

1 *provide that, upon completion of construction of the*
2 *bridge—*

3 *(1) the Secretary shall transfer to the city of Folsom*
4 *all right, title, and interest of the United States*
5 *to the bridge and connecting structures;*

6 *(2) the Secretary shall transfer to the city of Folsom*
7 *necessary easements to provide access to the*
8 *bridge; and*

9 *(3) the city of Folsom shall assume full responsibility*
10 *for operation and maintenance of the bridge*
11 *and connecting structures in perpetuity.*

12 *(e) FEDERAL SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost*
13 *of the project is as follows:*

14 *(1) If the project is constructed as a 2-lane*
15 *bridge, the project shall be constructed at full Federal*
16 *expense.*

17 *(2) If the project is constructed as a 4-lane*
18 *bridge, the city of Folsom shall be required to con-*
19 *tribute 20 percent of the cost of the project.*

20 *(f) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is*
21 *authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section a*
22 *total of \$50,000,000 for fiscal years beginning after Sep-*
23 *tember 30, 2003.*
