## A BILL

To ensure that a public safety officer who suffers a fatal heart attack or stroke while on duty shall be presumed to have died in the line of duty for purposes of public safety officer survivor benefits.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Hometown Heroes  
3 Survivors Benefits Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. FATAL HEART ATTACK OR STROKE ON DUTY PRE-**  
5 **SUMED TO BE DEATH IN LINE OF DUTY FOR**  
6 **PURPOSES OF PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICER SUR-**  
7 **VIVOR BENEFITS.**

8 Section 1201 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe  
9 Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3796) is amended by add-  
10 ing at the end the following new subsection:

11 “(k) For purposes of this section, if a public safety  
12 officer dies as the direct and proximate result of a heart  
13 attack or stroke suffered while on duty or within 24 hours  
14 after participating in a training exercise or responding to  
15 an emergency situation, that officer shall be presumed to  
16 have died as the direct and proximate result of a personal  
17 injury sustained in the line of duty.”.

18 **SEC. 3. APPLICABILITY.**

19 Subsection (k) of section 1201 of such Act (as added  
20 by section 2) shall apply to deaths occurring on or after  
21 January 1, 2002.
