## 1 Resolved,

## 2 SECTION 1. AMOUNTS FOR COMMITTEE EXPENSES.

For the expenses of the Committee on Small Business
4 (hereafter in this resolution referred to as the "Com5 mittee"), including the expenses of all staff salaries, there 6 shall be paid, out of the applicable accounts of the House 7 of Representatives for committee salaries and expenses, 8 not more than $\$ 6,372,008$ for the One Hundred Eighth 9 Congress.

## SEC. 2. SESSION LIMITATIONS.

Of the amount specified in section 1-
(1) not more than $\$ 3,080,591$ shall be available for expenses incurred during the period beginning at noon on January 3, 2003, and ending immediately before noon on January 3, 2004; and
(2) not more than $\$ 3,291,417$ shall be available for expenses incurred during the period beginning at noon on January 3, 2004, and ending immediately before noon on January 3, 2005.

## SEC. 3. VOUCHERS.

Payments under this resolution shall be made on vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the Chairman of the Committee, and approved in the manner directed by the Committee on House Administration.

## SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.

Amounts made available under this resolution shall be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by the Committee on House Administration.
