1 Resolved,

## 2 SECTION 1. AMOUNTS FOR COMMITTEE EXPENSES.

For the expenses of the Committee on Small Business (hereafter in this resolution referred to as the "Committee"), including the expenses of all staff salaries, there shall be paid, out of the applicable accounts of the House of Representatives for committee salaries and expenses, not more than \$6,372,008 for the One Hundred Eighth Congress.

#### 1 SEC. 2. SESSION LIMITATIONS.

2 Of the amount specified in section 1—

3 (1) not more than \$3,080,591 shall be available
4 for expenses incurred during the period beginning at
5 noon on January 3, 2003, and ending immediately
6 before noon on January 3, 2004; and

7 (2) not more than \$3,291,417 shall be available
8 for expenses incurred during the period beginning at
9 noon on January 3, 2004, and ending immediately
10 before noon on January 3, 2005.

#### 11 SEC. 3. VOUCHERS.

Payments under this resolution shall be made on
vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the
Chairman of the Committee, and approved in the manner
directed by the Committee on House Administration.

### 16 SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.

17 Amounts made available under this resolution shall18 be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by19 the Committee on House Administration.
