Mr. KUCINICH submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on International Relations

RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives with respect to a nationwide Town Hall meeting on the new foreign policy doctrines of the President.

1 *Resolved*, That it is the sense of the House of Rep-
2 representatives that the President should issue a
3 proclamation—

4 (1) calling upon all people of the United States
5 to participate in a Town Hall meeting to discuss the
6 following propositions:

7 (A) That the moral standing of the United
8 States in the world is the most important ele-
9 ment of domestic security.

1 (B) That unprovoked attacks by the
2 United States on other countries offend Amer-
3 ican values and anger the rest of the world.

4 (C) That the financial cost to the United
5 States of acting alone in international affairs
6 generally and in the war and reconstruction of
7 Iraq specifically will compel the Congress to
8 sacrifice funding for schools, child care, health
9 care, retirement security, and other domestic
10 priorities;

11 (2) pledging that the President will preside over
12 the Town Hall meeting, answer the people's ques-
13 tions, and hear the opinions of the people of the
14 United States on these matters of national signifi-
15 cance; and

16 (3) calling upon the local and national television
17 and radio media to make available their broadcast
18 capabilities to allow Americans from all parts of the
19 country to participate in the Town Hall meeting.
