Mr. TAYLOR of Mississippi submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H. J. Res. 22) proposing a balanced budget amendment to the Constitution of the United States.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution the Speaker shall, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the joint resolution (H. J. Res. 22) proposing a
6 balanced budget amendment to the Constitution of the
7 United States. General debate shall be confined to the
8 joint resolution and shall not exceed two hours equally di-
9 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-
10 ity member of the Committee on the Judiciary. After gen-

1 eral debate the joint resolution shall be considered for
2 amendment under the five-minute rule. At the conclusion
3 of consideration of the joint resolution for amendment the
4 Committee shall rise and report the joint resolution to the
5 House with such amendments as may have been adopted.
6 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
7 the joint resolution and amendments thereto to final pas-
8 sage without intervening motion except one motion to re-
9 commit with or without instructions.

10 SEC. 2. If the Committee of the Whole rises and re-
11 ports that it has come to no resolution on the joint resolu-
12 tion, then on the next legislative day the House shall, im-
13 mediately after the third daily order of business under
14 clause 1 of rule XIV, resolve into the Committee of the
15 Whole for further consideration of the joint resolution.
