Mr. SMITH of New Jersey (for himself and Mr. EVANS) submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

RESOLUTION

Providing amounts for further expenses of the Committee
on Veterans' Affairs in the One Hundred Eighth Congress.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. AMOUNTS FOR COMMITTEE EXPENSES.**

3 For further expenses of the Committee on Veterans'
4 Affairs (hereafter in this resolution referred to as the
5 “Committee”) for the One Hundred Eighth Congress,
6 there shall be paid out of the applicable accounts of the
7 House of Representatives not more than \$171,000.

8 **SEC. 2. SESSION LIMITATIONS.**

9 Of the amount specified in section 1—

1 (1) not more than \$69,000 shall be available for
2 expenses incurred during the period beginning at
3 noon on January 3, 2003, and ending immediately
4 before noon on January 3, 2004; and

5 (2) not more than \$102,000 shall be available
6 for expenses incurred during the period beginning at
7 noon on January 3, 2004, and ending immediately
8 before noon on January 3, 2005.

9 **SEC. 3. VOUCHERS.**

10 Payments under this resolution shall be made on
11 vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the
12 Chairman of the Committee, and approved in the manner
13 directed by the Committee on House Administration.

14 **SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.**

15 Amounts made available under this resolution shall
16 be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by
17 the Committee on House Administration.
