Providing amounts for further expenses of the Committee on Veterans' Affairs in the One Hundred Eighth Congress.

- 1 Resolved,
- 2 SECTION 1. AMOUNTS FOR COMMITTEE EXPENSES.
- 3 For further expenses of the Committee on Veterans'
- 4 Affairs (hereafter in this resolution referred to as the
- 5 "Committee") for the One Hundred Eighth Congress,
- 6 there shall be paid out of the applicable accounts of the
- 7 House of Representatives not more than \$171,000.
- 8 SEC. 2. SESSION LIMITATIONS.
- 9 Of the amount specified in section 1—

- 1 (1) not more than \$69,000 shall be available for 2 expenses incurred during the period beginning at 3 noon on January 3, 2003, and ending immediately 4 before noon on January 3, 2004; and 5 (2) not more than \$102,000 shall be available
- 5 (2) not more than \$102,000 shall be available 6 for expenses incurred during the period beginning at 7 noon on January 3, 2004, and ending immediately 8 before noon on January 3, 2005.

### 9 SEC. 3. VOUCHERS.

- 10 Payments under this resolution shall be made on
- 11 vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the
- 12 Chairman of the Committee, and approved in the manner
- 13 directed by the Committee on House Administration.

#### 14 SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.

- 15 Amounts made available under this resolution shall
- 16 be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by
- 17 the Committee on House Administration.
