## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2427) to authorize the Secretary of Health and Human Services to promulgate regulations for the reimportation of prescription drugs, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution  
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of  
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 2427) to  
4 authorize the Secretary of Health and Human Services to  
5 promulgate regulations for the reimportation of prescrip-  
6 tion drugs, and for other purposes. The bill shall be con-

1 sidered as read for amendment. The previous question  
2 shall be considered as ordered on the bill to final passage  
3 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate  
4 on the bill equally divided and controlled by the chairman  
5 and ranking minority member of the Committee on En-  
6 ergy and Commerce or their designees; and (2) one motion  
7 to recommit.

8       SEC. 2. During consideration of H.R. 2427 pursuant  
9 to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation of the  
10 previous question, the Chair may postpone further consid-  
11 eration of the bill to a time designated by the Speaker.
