- 6 ered as read for amendment. The previous question shall
- 7 be considered as ordered on the bill and on any amend-

- 1 ment thereto to final passage without intervening motion
- 2 except: (1) one hour of debate on the bill equally divided
- 3 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority
- 4 member of the Committee on Appropriations; (2) an
- 5 amendment printed in the Congressional Record pursuant
- 6 to clause 8 of rule XVIII, if offered by Representative
- 7 Toomey of Pennsylvania or his designee, which shall be
- 8 in order without intervention of any point of order or de-
- 9 mand for division of the question, shall be considered as
- 10 read, and shall be separately debatable for 20 minutes
- 11 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an
- 12 opponent; and (3) one motion to recommit with or without
- 13 instructions.

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
