Whereas Dr. David Kelly contributed his expertise in microbiology to the Government of the United Kingdom as a scientific advisor to the Proliferation and Arms Control Secretariat of the United Kingdom's Ministry of Defence;

Whereas Dr. David Kelly's courageous work for the United Nations Special Commission (UNSCOM), which between 1991 and 1998 was charged with dismantling Iraq's banned chemical, biological, and ballistic programs, earned him the great respect of world arms control experts and made the world safer for us all;

Whereas Dr. David Kelly had a leading role in the inspections of Russian biological warfare facilities until 1994

under the 1992 trilateral agreement between the United States of America, the United Kingdom, and Russia and aided in reducing the danger of biological weapons in Russia;

Whereas Dr. David Kelly's professional life was characterized by his integrity, honor, and dedication to finding the truth; and

Whereas David Kelly will be deeply missed by his loving wife Janice, and his three daughters Sian, Rachel, and Ellen:
