RESOLUTION

Urging the President to establish an Iraq service medal to
recognize service by members of the Armed Forces in
Operation Iraqi Freedom.

1 *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives urges
2 the President to establish a new Armed Forces service
3 medal, to be known as the “Iraq Service Medal”, to be
4 awarded to all members of the Armed Forces who serve,
5 during such period as may be prescribed by the President
6 or Secretary of Defense, in the theater of operations for
7 Operation Iraqi Freedom.
