RESOLUTION

Congratulating Jeffrey Sean Lehman on his appointment
to the presidency of Cornell University.

Whereas Jeffrey Sean Lehman took office as Cornell University's 11th president on July 1, 2003;

Whereas Ezra Cornell and Andrew Dickson White established Cornell University in the State of New York in 1865;

Whereas Cornell University is the federally designated land grant institution in the State of New York;

Whereas Cornell University comprises fourteen colleges and schools, including seven undergraduate units and four graduate and professional units in Ithaca, New York, two

medical graduate and professional units in New York City, and one medical unit in Doha, Qatar;

Whereas Jeffrey Sean Lehman earned a bachelor's degree in mathematics from Cornell in 1977 and two advanced degrees from the University of Michigan in 1981, a J.D. and a master's degree in public policy;

Whereas Jeffrey Sean Lehman was named dean of the University of Michigan Law School at the age of 37 in 1994, and became, at the time, the youngest dean of any law school in the United States;

Whereas Jeffrey Sean Lehman, a member of a three-generation Cornell family, is the first Cornell University alumnus to lead the University; and

Whereas the students, alumni, staff, faculty, and supporters of Cornell University are to be commended for identifying a president with integrity, intellect, and scholarship;
