1       *Resolved*, That—

2               (1) the President is requested to transmit to

3       the House of Representatives not later than the date

1       that is 14 days after the date of the adoption of this  
2       resolution, all documents, including telephone and  
3       electronic mail records, logs and calendars, personnel  
4       records, and records of internal discussions in the  
5       possession of the President relating to the disclosure  
6       of the identity of Ms. Valerie Plame as an employee  
7       of the Central Intelligence Agency during the period  
8       beginning on May 6, 2003, and ending on July 31,  
9       2003; and

10           (2) the Secretary of State, the Secretary of De-  
11       fense, and the Attorney General are each directed to  
12       transmit to the House of Representatives not later  
13       than such date, all documents, including telephone  
14       and electronic mail records, logs and calendars, and  
15       records of internal discussions in the possession of  
16       the Secretary of State, the Secretary of Defense,  
17       and the Attorney General, respectively, relating to  
18       such disclosure during such period.
