## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 594) to amend title II of the Social Security Act to repeal the Government pension offset and windfall elimination provisions.

1       *Resolved*, That, immediately upon the adoption of this  
2 resolution, the House shall without intervention of any  
3 point of order consider in the House the bill (H.R. 594)  
4 to amend title II of the Social Security Act to repeal the  
5 Government pension offset and windfall elimination provi-  
6 sions. The bill shall be considered as read for amendment.  
7 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on

1 the bill and on any amendment thereto to final passage  
2 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate  
3 on the bill equally divided and controlled by the chairman  
4 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways  
5 and Means; (2) an amendment in the nature of a sub-  
6 stitute printed in the Congressional Record pursuant to  
7 clause 8 of rule XVIII, if offered by the Majority Leader  
8 or his designee, which shall be in order without interven-  
9 tion of any point of order (except those arising under  
10 clause 7 of rule XVI), shall be considered as read, and  
11 shall be separately debatable for one hour equally divided  
12 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent; and (3)  
13 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
