RESOLUTION

Providing amounts for interim expenses of the Select Committee on Homeland Security in the first session of the One Hundred Eighth Congress.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. INTERIM EXPENSES OF THE SELECT COM-**
3 **MITTEE ON HOMELAND SECURITY.**

4 For interim expenses of the Select Committee on
5 Homeland Security, there shall be paid out of the applica-
6 ble accounts of the House of Representatives not more
7 than \$700,000.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION.**

2 Amounts shall be available under this resolution for
3 expenses incurred during the period beginning at noon on
4 January 3, 2003, and ending at midnight on March 31,
5 2003.

6 **SEC. 3. VOUCHERS.**

7 Payments under this resolution shall be made on
8 vouchers authorized by the Select Committee on Home-
9 land Security, signed by the chairman of such committee,
10 and approved in the manner directed by the Committee
11 on House Administration.

12 **SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.**

13 Amounts made available under this resolution shall
14 be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by
15 the Committee on House Administration.

16 **SEC. 5. ADJUSTMENT AUTHORITY.**

17 The Committee on House Administration shall have
18 authority to make adjustments in amounts under section
19 1, if necessary to comply with an order of the President
20 issued under section 254 of the Balanced Budget and
21 Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 or to conform to
22 any reduction in appropriations for the purposes of such
23 section 1.

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
