# 2 SECTION 1. AMOUNTS FOR COMMITTEE EXPENSES.

For the expenses of the Committee on the Judiciary (hereafter in this resolution referred to as the "Committee"), including the expenses of all staff salaries, there shall be paid, out of the applicable accounts of the House of Representatives for committee salaries and expenses, not more than \$17,248,066.50 for the One Hundred Eighth Congress.

7 (2) not more than \$8,825,346.20 shall be avail8 able for expenses incurred during the period begin9 ning at noon on January 3, 2004, and ending imme10 diately before noon on January 3, 2005.

#### 11 SEC. 3. VOUCHERS.

12 Payments under this resolution shall be made on 13 vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the 14 Chairman of the Committee, and approved in the manner 15 directed by the Committee on House Administration.

### 16 SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.

17 Amounts made available under this resolution shall18 be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by19 the Committee on House Administration.
