1 *Resolved*, That unless otherwise ordered, before Mon-

3 shall be 2 p.m. on Mondays; noon on Tuesdays; and 10
4 a.m. on all other days of the week; and from Monday, May
5 19, 2003, until the end of the first session, the hour of
6 daily meeting of the House shall be noon on Mondays; 10
7 a.m. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays; and 9
8 a.m. on all other days of the week.
