- 7 (a) In General.—Section 924 of title 18, United
- 8 States Code, is amended—
- 9 (1) in subsection (a)—

1	(A) in paragraph (2), by striking "(i),
2	(j),''; and
3	(B) by adding at the end the following:
4	"(8) Whoever knowingly violates subsection (i)
5	or (j) of section 922 shall be fined under this title,
6	imprisoned not more than 15 years, or both.";
7	(2) in subsection (i)(1), by striking "10 years"
8	and inserting "15 years"; and
9	(3) in subsection (l) , by striking "10 years" and
10	inserting "15 years".
11	(b) SENTENCING COMMISSION.—The United States
12	Sentencing Commission shall amend the Federal sen-
13	tencing guidelines to reflect the amendments made under
14	subsection (a).
