3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF ANTIDUMPING PROVISION OF REV-**
4 **ENUE ACT OF 1916.**

5 (a) REPEAL.—Section 801 of the Act entitled “An
6 Act to increase the revenue, and for other purposes”, ap-
7 proved September 8, 1916 (15 U.S.C. 72), is repealed.

8 (b) EFFECT OF REPEAL.—The repeal made by sub-
9 section (a) shall not affect any action under section 801
10 of the Act referred to in subsection (a) that was com-

- 1 menced before the date of the enactment of this Act and
- 2 is pending on such date.
