Mr. Graham of Florida (for himself, Mr. Nelson of Florida, and Mr. Sessions) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs

## A BILL

To require the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to establish national cemeteries for geographically underserved populations of veterans, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF NATIONAL CEMETERIES
- 4 FOR GEOGRAPHICALLY UNDERSERVED POP-
- 5 ULATIONS OF VETERANS.
- 6 (a) Identification of Underserved Burial
- 7 Service Areas.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall
- 8 identify the 10 burial service areas in the United States
- 9 that, as determined by the Secretary, are most in need

- 1 of a new national cemetery in order to ensure that 90 per-
- 2 cent of the veterans who reside in each such service area
- 3 live within 75 miles of a national cemetery.
- 4 (b) Burial Service Area.—For purposes of this
- 5 section, the term "burial service area" means a service
- 6 area for burial in national cemeteries that is established
- 7 by the Secretary utilizing the most current population
- 8 data available to the Secretary as of the date of the enact-
- 9 ment of this Act, which service area—
- 10 (1) has a radius of approximately 75 miles;
- 11 (2) contains a minimum population of veterans
- of approximately 170,000 veterans; and
- 13 (3) is not served as of the date of the enact-
- ment of this Act by a national cemetery or State
- 15 cemetery for veterans.
- 16 (c) Establishment of National Cemeteries.—
- 17 The Secretary shall establish, in accordance with chapter
- 18 24 of title 38, United States Code, a national cemetery
- 19 in each burial service area identified under subsection (a)
- 20 in order to serve the burial needs of veterans and their
- 21 families.
- 22 (d) ADVANCE PLANNING.—(1) The Secretary shall
- 23 carry out in fiscal year 2004 such activities as the Sec-
- 24 retary considers appropriate for advance planning for the
- 25 establishment of national cemeteries under subsection (c).

- 1 (2) Amounts appropriated for fiscal year 2004 for the
- 2 advance planning fund in the Construction, Major
- 3 Projects account shall be available for activities under
- 4 paragraph (1).
- 5 (e) Reports.—(1) Not later than 120 days after the
- 6 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall sub-
- 7 mit to Congress a report on the establishment of national
- 8 cemeteries under subsection (c). The report shall set forth
- 9 the following:
- 10 (A) Each burial service area identified by the
- 11 Secretary under subsection (a) to require the estab-
- 12 lishment of a national cemetery under subsection
- 13 (c).
- (B) A schedule for the establishment of each
- such national cemetery.
- 16 (C) An estimate of the costs of the establish-
- 17 ment of each such national cemetery.
- 18 (D) The amount to be obligated under sub-
- section (d) during fiscal year 2004 for advance plan-
- 20 ning required under that subsection.
- 21 (2) Not later than one year after the date of the re-
- 22 port under paragraph (1), and annually thereafter until
- 23 the completion of each national cemetery required by sub-
- 24 section (c), the Secretary shall submit to Congress an up-

- 1 date of the report under that paragraph (as previously up-
- 2 dated, if at all, under this paragraph).
