3 **SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN COUNTRIES FOR**
4 **UNITED STATES MILITARY ASSISTANCE.**

5 (a) AMENDMENT.—Section 2007(d)(1) of the Amer-
6 ican Servicemembers' Protection Act of 2002 (title II of

1 the 2002 Supplemental Appropriations Act for Further
2 Recovery From and Response To Terrorist Attacks on the
3 United States (Public Law 107–206; 116 Stat. 905)) is
4 amended by inserting “or a country that has concluded
5 a protocol with NATO for the accession of the country
6 to NATO” before the semicolon.

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
8 subsection (a) takes effect on July 1, 2003.
