2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MANDATORY FUNDING OF IDEA.**

4 Section 611(j) of the Individuals with Disabilities
5 Education Act (29 U.S.C. 1411(j)) is amended to read
6 as follows:

7 “(j) MANDATORY FUNDING.—For the purpose of car-
8 rying out this part, other than section 619, there are au-
9 thorized to be appropriated, and there are appropriated,

1 such sums as may be necessary for fiscal year 2004 and
2 each subsequent fiscal year to fully fund 40 percent of
3 the average per pupil expenditure for programs under this
4 part, other than section 619.”.
