 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.
 - 4 The United States Courthouse located at Wright
 - 5 Square, 125 Bull Street, Savannah, Georgia, shall be
 - 6 known and designated as the "Tomochichi Federal Judi-
 - 7 cial Center".

1 SEC. 2. REFERENCES.

- 2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
- 3 paper, or other record of the United States to the United
- 4 States Courthouse referred to in section 1 shall be deemed
- 5 to be a reference to the Tomochichi Federal Judicial Cen-
- 6 ter.

7 SEC. 3. APPLICABILITY.

- 8 The designation under section 1, and any reference
- 9 to the building described in that section, shall apply in
- 10 all respects to any construction or adaptation, after the
- 11 date of enactment of this Act, of any building that—
- 12 (1) is occupied, in whole or in part, by the
- United States District Court for the Southern Dis-
- trict of Georgia; and
- 15 (2) is adjacent to or connected with the United
- 16 States Courthouse at Wright Square.
