A BILL

To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to extend medicare cost-sharing for qualifying individuals through 2004.

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF MEDICARE COST-SHARING FOR**

4 **QUALIFYING INDIVIDUALS THROUGH FISCAL**

5 **YEAR 2004.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1902(a)(10)(E)(iv) of the

7 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396a(a)(10)(E)(iv)) is

8 amended to read as follows:

1 “(iv) subject to sections 1933 and
2 1905(p)(4), for making medical assistance
3 available (but only for premiums payable with
4 respect to months during the period beginning
5 with January 1998, and ending with December
6 2004) for medicare cost-sharing described in
7 section 1905(p)(3)(A)(ii) for individuals who
8 would be qualified medicare beneficiaries de-
9 scribed in section 1905(p)(1) but for the fact
10 that their income exceeds the income level es-
11 tablished by the State under section 1905(p)(2)
12 and is at least 120 percent, but less than 135
13 percent, of the official poverty line (referred to
14 in such section) for a family of the size involved
15 and who are not otherwise eligible for medical
16 assistance under the State plan;”.

17 (b) STATE ALLOCATIONS.—Section 1933(c) of the
18 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396u-3(c)) is amended—

19 (1) in paragraph (1)—

20 (A) in subparagraph (D), by striking
21 “and” at the end;

22 (B) in subparagraph (E)—

23 (i) by striking “fiscal year 2002” and
24 inserting “each of fiscal years 2002
25 through 2004”; and
