## AN ACT

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction  
of a hydroelectric project in the State of Wyoming.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR THE FEDERAL EN-**  
2 **ERGY REGULATORY COMMISSION HYDRO-**  
3 **ELECTRIC PROJECT.**

4 Notwithstanding the time period specified in section  
5 13 of Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would oth-  
6 erwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commis-  
7 sion project numbered 1651, the Commission may, at the  
8 request of the licensee for the project, and after reasonable  
9 notice, in accordance with the good faith, due diligence,  
10 and public interest requirements of that section and the  
11 Commission's procedures under that section, extend the  
12 time period during which the licensee is required to com-  
13 mence the construction of the project for three consecutive  
14 two-year periods from the date of the expiration of the  
15 extension originally issued by the Commission.
