## A BILL

To amend the Head Start Act to improve provisions relating to updating population data.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. UPDATING POPULATION DATA.**

4 Section 640(a)(4) of the Head Start Act (42 U.S.C.  
5 9835(a)(4)) is amended in the flush matter following sub-  
6 paragraph (B)—

7 (1) by striking “shall use the most recent data  
8 available” and inserting “shall use data that is not  
9 more than 2 years old”; and

- 1 (2) by striking “use of the most recent data
- 2 available” and inserting “such data”.
