- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Pretrial Detention and

- 6 SEC. 2. PRESUMPTION FOR PRETRIAL DETENTION IN
- 7 CASES INVOLVING TERRORISM.
- 8 Section 3142 of title 18, United States Code, is
