1 **SECTION 1. MAINTENANCE OF INCREASED RATE OF HOS-**

4 (a) RATE.—Section 310(a) of title 37, United States
5 Code, is amended by striking “\$150” and inserting
6 “\$225”.

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
8 subsection (a) shall take effect on October 1, 2003.

9 **SEC. 2. MAINTENANCE OF INCREASED RATE OF FAMILY**
10 **SEPARATION ALLOWANCE.**

11 (a) RATE.—Section 427(a)(1) of title 37, United
12 States Code, is amended by striking “\$100” and inserting
13 “\$250”.

14 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
15 subsection (a) shall take effect on October 1, 2003.
