2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. OATH OF RENUNCIATION AND ALLEGIANCE.**

4 Section 337(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
5 Act (8 U.S.C. 1448(a)) is amended by inserting after “the

7 “The oath referred to in this section shall read the same

1 as the oath provided for in paragraph (a) or (b) of part
2 337.1 of title 8, Code of Federal Regulations, as in effect
3 on September 1, 2003.”.
