## A BILL

For the relief of Katarina Galovic.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4       Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-  
5       poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
6       1101 et seq.), Katarina Galovic, the daughter of former  
7       Yugoslavian diplomats, shall be held and considered to  
8       have been lawfully admitted to the United States for per-  
9       manent residence as of the date of the enactment of this  
10      Act upon payment of the required visa fee.

1 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

2       Upon the granting of permanent residence to  
3 Katarina Galovic as provided in this Act, the Secretary  
4 of State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1  
5 during the current fiscal year the total number of immi-  
6 grant visas available to natives of the country of the alien's  
7 birth under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nation-  
8 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
