Mr. STEVENS introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred

A BILL

For the relief of Gustav F.K. Wallner.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
6 1101 et seq.), Gustav F.K. Wallner shall be held and con-
7 sidered to have been lawfully admitted to the United
8 States for permanent residence as of the date of the enact-
9 ment of this Act upon payment of the required visa fee.

10 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

11 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Gustav
12 F.K. Wallner as provided in this Act, the Secretary of

1 State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 1 dur-
2 ing the current fiscal year the total number of immigrant
3 visas available to natives of the country of the alien's birth
4 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
5 Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
