A BILL

To amend chapter 5 of title 28, United States Code, to provide for the approval of the reassignment of district judges in divisions with 3 or fewer judges in districts in the State of Texas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REASSIGNMENT OF DISTRICT JUDGES IN CER-**
4 **TAIN DISTRICTS IN THE STATE OF TEXAS.**

5 Section 134(c) of title 28, United States Code, is
6 amended—

7 (1) by inserting “(1)” after “(c)”; and

8 (2) by adding at the end the following:

1 “(2) The district judges of any district court in
2 the State of Texas may not reassign any district
3 judge, whose duty station is in a division with 3 or
4 fewer judges, to a duty station in another division of
5 that district, without the consent of all of the dis-
6 trict judges of that district.”.
