3 **SECTION 1. BRIAN C. HICKEY POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 339 Hicksville Road in Bethpage,

1 New York, shall be known and designated as the “Brian
2 C. Hickey Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the Brian C. Hickey Post
7 Office Building.
