3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON USE OF CERTAIN CONSERVA-**  
4 **TION FUNDING FOR TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE**  
5 **FOR CONSERVATION RESERVE PROGRAM.**

6 Section 1241(b)(1) of the Food Security Act of 1985  
7 (16 U.S.C. 3841(b)(1)) is amended by inserting before the

- 2 tion reserve program under subchapter B of chapter 1)”.
