3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF SUNSET PROVISION.**

4 Section 2(f)(2) of the Undetectable Firearms Act of  
5 1988 (Public Law 100–649; 18 U.S.C. 922 note) is  
6 amended by striking “SUNSET.—Effective 15 years” and  
7 inserting “SUNSET.—Effective 25 years”.
