A BILL

To extend the Temporary Extended Unemployment
Compensation Act of 2002.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Workers Assistance
5 Extension Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF THE TEMPORARY EXTENDED UNEM-**
7 **PLOYMENT COMPENSATION ACT OF 2002.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 208 of the Temporary Ex-
9 tended Unemployment Compensation Act of 2002 (Public
10 Law 107–147; 116 Stat. 30), as amended by Public Law

1 108–1 (117 Stat. 3) and Public Law 108–26 (117 Stat.
2 751), is amended—

3 (1) in subsection (a)(2), by striking “December
4 31, 2003” and inserting “June 30, 2004”;

5 (2) in subsection (b)(1), by striking “December
6 31, 2003” and inserting “June 30, 2004”;

7 (3) in subsection (b)(2)—

8 (A) in the heading, by striking “DECEM-
9 BER 31, 2003” and inserting “JUNE 30, 2004”;

10 and

11 (B) by striking “December 31, 2003” and
12 inserting “June 30, 2004”; and

13 (4) in subsection (b)(3), by striking “March 31,
14 2004” and inserting “September 30, 2004”.

15 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
16 this section shall take effect as if included in the enact-
17 ment of the Temporary Extended Unemployment Com-
18 pensation Act of 2002 (Public Law 107–147; 116 Stat.
19 21).
