## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to establish a presumption of service-connection for certain veterans with Hepatitis C, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PRESUMPTION OF SERVICE-CONNECTION FOR
- 4 CERTAIN VETERANS WITH HEPATITIS C.
- 5 (a) Presumption.—Section 1112 of title 38, United
- 6 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 7 lowing:
- 8 "(d)(1) For the purposes of section 1110 of this title,
- 9 and subject to the provisions of section 1113 of this title,
- 10 the disease Hepatitis C becoming manifest to a degree of

- 1 10 percent or more in any veteran described in paragraph
- 2 (2) after active military, naval, or air service covered by
- 3 that paragraph shall be considered to have been incurred
- 4 in or aggravated by such service, notwithstanding that
- 5 there is no record of evidence of that disease during such
- 6 service.
- 7 "(2) Paragraph (1) applies in the case of the fol-
- 8 lowing:
- 9 "(A) Veterans who received during a period of
- service before December 31, 1992, a transfusion of
- 11 blood or blood products.
- 12 "(B) Veterans who were exposed to blood
- through the skin during a period of service.
- 14 "(C) Veterans who underwent hemodialysis dur-
- ing a period of service.
- 16 "(D) Veterans who experienced a needle-stick
- injury, not due to the veteran's own willful mis-
- 18 conduct, during a period of service.
- 19 "(E) Veterans diagnosed with unexplained liver
- disease during a period of service.
- 21 "(F) Veterans who served in a health-care posi-
- 22 tion or specialty during a period of service under
- such circumstances as the Secretary shall prescribe
- for purposes of this subsection.".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date of the enact-
- 3 ment of this Act. No benefit may be paid or provided by

4 reason of that amendment for any period before such date.
