## A BILL

For the relief of Robert Kuan Liang and Chun-Mei Hsu-Liang.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR ROBERT**  
4 **KUAN LIANG AND CHUN-MEI HSU-LIANG.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)  
6 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality  
7 Act, Robert Kuan Liang and Chun-Mei Hsu-Liang shall  
8 be eligible for the issuance of immigrant visas or for ad-  
9 justment of status to that of aliens lawfully admitted for  
10 permanent residence upon filing an application for

1 issuance of immigrant visas under section 204 of that Act  
2 or for adjustment of status to lawful permanent resident.

3 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Robert Kuan  
4 Liang and Chun-Mei Hsu-Liang enter the United States  
5 before the filing deadline specified in subsection (c), Rob-  
6 ert Kuan Liang and Chun-Mei Hsu-Liang shall be consid-  
7 ered to have entered and remained lawfully and shall be  
8 eligible for adjustment of status under section 245 of the  
9 Immigration and Nationality Act as of the date of enact-  
10 ment of this Act.

11 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF  
12 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-  
13 plication for issuance of immigrant visas or the application  
14 for adjustment of status are filed with appropriate fees  
15 within 2 years after the date of enactment of this Act.

16 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBERS.—  
17 Upon the granting of immigrant visas or permanent resi-  
18 dence to Robert Kuan Liang and Chun-Mei Hsu-Liang,  
19 the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper officer to  
20 reduce by 2, during the current or next following fiscal  
21 year, the total number of immigrant visas that are made  
22 available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth  
23 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality  
24 Act or, if applicable, the total number of immigrant visas

1 that are made available to natives of the country of the  
2 aliens' birth under section 202(e) of that Act.
