Mr. ALLEN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works

A BILL

To designate a portion of the United States courthouse located at 2100 Jamieson Avenue, in Alexandria, Virginia, as the “Justin W. Williams United States Attorney’s Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The building and structure de-
5 scribed in subsection (b) shall be known and designated
6 as the “Justin W. Williams United States Attorney’s
7 Building”.

1 (b) DESCRIPTION.—The building and structure to be
2 designated under subsection (a) is that portion of the
3 United States courthouse located at 2100 Jamieson Ave-
4 nue, in Alexandria, Virginia (commonly known as the
5 Albert V. Bryan United States Courthouse), that is at-
6 tached to the courthouse main tower structure, described
7 as “A-Wing” in the architectural plans, and currently oc-
8 cupied by the Office of the United States Attorney for the
9 Eastern District of Virginia, Alexandria Division.

10 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

11 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
12 paper, or other record of the United States to the building
13 and structure described in section 1(b) shall be deemed
14 to be a reference to the Justin W. Williams United States
15 Attorney’s Building.

16 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

17 There are authorized to be appropriated such sums
18 as are necessary for—

19 (1) appropriate identifying designations to be
20 affixed to the building and structure described in
21 section 1(b); and

22 (2) an appropriate plaque reflecting the des-
23 ignation under section 1, and honoring Justin W.
24 Williams and his service to the United States, to be

- 1 affixed to or displayed in that building and struc-
- 2 ture.
